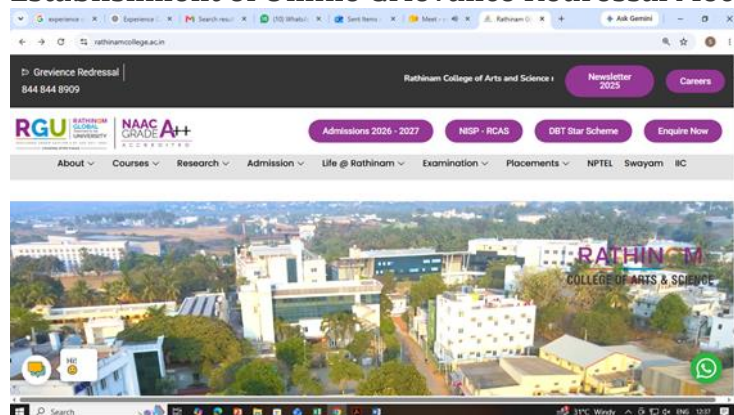
Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Faculty, Staff and Students

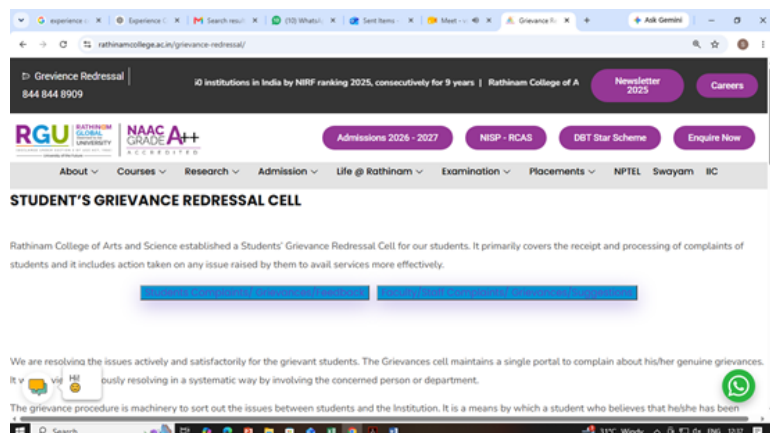

ADMISSION POLICY

UNDERGRADUATE (UG) ADMISSION POLICY

Eligibility

Candidates seeking admission to an Undergraduate programme shall have:

1. Passed the qualifying examination prescribed for the particular programme.

2. Obtained the minimum marks/grades prescribed by the College and applicable statutory/regulatory authorities.
3. Satisfied subject-specific requirements wherever prescribed.
4. Fulfilled any additional eligibility requirements applicable to professional programmes.

Candidates appearing for the qualifying examination may be considered provisionally, subject to successful completion and production of the qualifying certificate within the prescribed period.

UG Admission Process

The admission process may consist of:

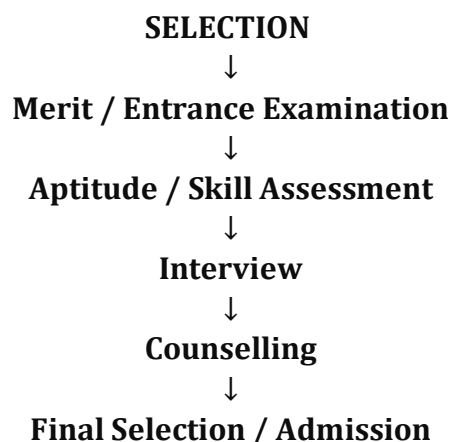
Step 1 – Online/Offline Application

The candidate shall submit the prescribed application form along with the required information and documents.

Step 2 – Eligibility Verification

The Admission Office shall verify the candidate's academic eligibility.

Step 3 – Selection



Step 4 – Merit/Selection List

The College shall publish the selected/wait-listed candidates through appropriate official channels.

Step 5 – Admission Confirmation

Admission shall be confirmed after:

- Verification of original documents;

- Payment of prescribed fees;
- Completion of registration formalities; and
- Fulfilment of all applicable eligibility requirements.

POSTGRADUATE (PG) ADMISSION POLICY

Eligibility

Candidates seeking admission to a Postgraduate programme shall possess:

1. A Bachelor's degree in the relevant/approved discipline from a recognized College /Institution; and
2. The minimum percentage/grade prescribed for the respective programme.

Where a programme has specific subject prerequisites, candidates shall satisfy such requirements.

For professional programmes, the eligibility requirements prescribed by the concerned statutory/professional regulatory body shall also apply.

PG Selection Procedure

Admission to PG programmes may be based on:

- Bachelor's degree/qualifying examination merit;
- College -level entrance examination;
- National/state-level entrance examination;
- Programme-specific aptitude test;
- Interview;
- Counselling; or
- A combination of the above.

The specific admission criteria shall be notified separately for each academic programme.

Ph.D. ADMISSION POLICY

The Ph.D. admission process shall be governed by the applicable UGC Regulations and the College approved Ph.D. Regulations.

The UGC Ph.D. Regulations, 2022 prescribe the minimum standards and procedure for admission and award of the Ph.D. degree.

Eligibility

A candidate seeking admission to the Ph.D. programme shall normally possess a Master's degree or a professional degree equivalent to a Master's degree, with the minimum marks/grade prescribed under the applicable UGC Regulations and College Ph.D. Regulations.

The College shall provide applicable relaxation in minimum marks/grade to eligible categories as prescribed by UGC and other competent authorities from time to time.

Candidates possessing qualifications from foreign institutions shall satisfy the applicable equivalence/recognition requirements.

Ph.D. Admission Process

Admission shall ordinarily involve:

1. Notification of available research areas and seats.
2. Submission of application.
3. Scrutiny of eligibility.
4. College /approved entrance examination, wherever applicable.
5. Interview/viva voce.
6. Assessment of research interest and proposed area of research.
7. Final selection based on the approved Ph.D. admission criteria.
8. Allocation of Research Supervisor subject to applicable rules and availability.
9. Provisional registration followed by completion of prescribed coursework and other requirements.

Candidates exempted from the entrance examination under the applicable UGC Regulations shall be considered according to the College Ph.D. Regulations.

The College shall maintain transparency in the selection and supervisor allocation process.

RESERVATION AND EQUITY

The College shall comply with reservation and equity provisions applicable to it under the governing Act, UGC Regulations, Government notifications and other applicable statutory provisions.

The College shall make reasonable efforts to ensure equitable access to higher education for:

- Scheduled Castes (SC) – 15%
- Scheduled Tribes (ST) - 7.5%
- Other Backward Classes (OBC) – 27%

- Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) – 10%
- Persons with Disabilities (PwD) – 5% Horizontal Reservation
- Other categories – As per applicable government / UGC Provision

Any relaxation in eligibility, fees, entrance requirements or other admission conditions shall be provided only where authorized under applicable regulations.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION

International students shall be admitted in accordance with applicable UGC and Government of India guidelines.

The College shall prescribe appropriate procedures relating to:

- Academic eligibility;
- Equivalence of foreign qualifications;
- Passport/visa requirements;
- English-language requirements, where applicable;
- International student registration;
- Fee payment;
- Documentation; and
- Compliance with applicable Government requirements.

The College may establish an International Students Office/Cell for facilitating such admissions.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

Depending on the programme, candidates shall submit/produce:

1. Completed application form.
2. Recent passport-size photographs.
3. Proof of identity.
4. Date-of-birth proof.
5. Qualifying examination mark sheets.
6. Transfer Certificate (TC), wherever applicable.
7. Migration Certificate, wherever applicable.
8. Community/Caste Certificate, wherever applicable.

9. EWS certificate, wherever applicable.
10. PwD certificate, wherever applicable.
11. Entrance examination score card, wherever applicable.
12. Degree/Provisional Certificate for PG/Ph.D. admissions.
13. Conduct/Character Certificate, wherever required.
14. Medical fitness certificate, wherever applicable.
15. Aadhaar or other officially accepted identification, subject to applicable requirements.
16. Any additional document prescribed by the College or statutory authority.

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

The College shall verify the authenticity of academic and other supporting documents submitted by candidates.

Where discrepancies or fraudulent documentation are identified:

- Admission may be withheld or cancelled;
- The candidate may be denied registration;
- Fees/refund shall be governed by applicable regulations; and
- Appropriate action may be initiated under College rules and applicable law.

FEE REFUND POLICY

Admission fees and other charges shall be published transparently before admission.

Candidates shall receive an official fee receipt for all payments.

Refund of fees in case of withdrawal/cancellation shall be governed by the applicable UGC regulations, Government directions and College -approved refund policy prevailing for the relevant academic year.

ADMISSION THROUGH ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Where an entrance examination is prescribed, the College shall publish:

- Examination eligibility;
- Syllabus;
- Examination pattern;
- Application schedule;

- Examination date;
- Selection methodology;
- Weightage, if applicable;
- Counselling procedure; and
- Tie-breaking criteria.

National and state-level entrance examination requirements shall be followed wherever mandated.

MERIT LIST AND WAITING LIST

The College shall prepare merit/selection lists based on the approved admission criteria.

Where two or more candidates obtain equal merit, tie-breaking shall be conducted using criteria notified in advance for the respective programme.

A waiting list may be maintained to fill vacancies arising from non-reporting or withdrawal of selected candidates.

ADMISSION COMMITTEE

The College shall constitute an Admission Committee consisting of appropriate academic and administrative representatives.

The Committee shall be responsible for:

1. Recommending admission procedures.
2. Monitoring implementation of the Admission Policy.
3. Ensuring transparency and fairness.
4. Reviewing eligibility and selection criteria.
5. Monitoring admission-related grievances.
6. Ensuring compliance with UGC and statutory requirements.
7. Recommending amendments to admission procedures when required.

Any amendment shall be approved by the competent statutory authority as & when required by the College.

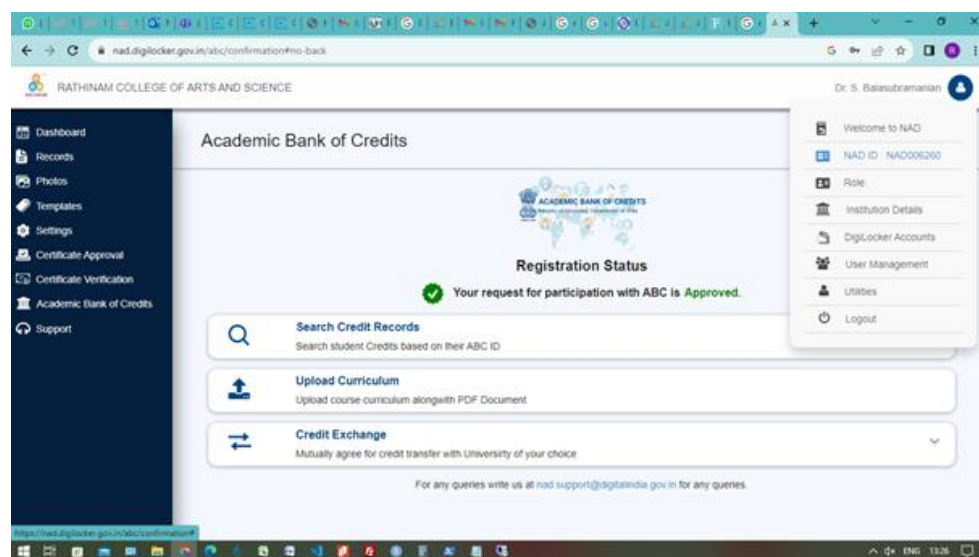
